A student's second year of the Missionary Leadership Institute follows successful completion of the Intensive Year and commissioning as a missionary disciple. Lay Apostolate Formation serves those who want to continue growing as leaders who will transform the world for Christ in their particular apostolate.

MLI Lay Apostolate Formation Requirements:

- Ongoing Check-ins with Institute staff:
 - Initial between June and August
 - Mid-Year between December and January
 - End of year advisement meeting April
- Completion of a minimum of six online courses or Diocesan workshops
- Fulfillment of the Intercultural Competency course requirement
- Cohort "Night of Learning"
 - Thursday, November 13, 2025, 6:00 PM 8:30 PM
- Cohort "Dinner and Discussion: End of the Year Celebration"
 - Thursday, April 30, 2026, 6:00 PM 7:30 PM
- Upon completion, students receive a Certificate of Completion.
